Chicago Re-Entry Center Success

Three-year recidivism results from BI's Chicago Re-Entry Center program, operated for the Illinois Department of Corrections, indicate a 40.6 percent reduction in new criminal convictions.* Illinois taxpayers saved \$3.6 million, and 263 new felonies were avoided in the first three years of the center's operations. Similar outcomes can be achieved in communities throughout the county.

* The study compared 1503 program participants, including those who did not complete the program, to a control group of 871 closely matched parolees who did not participate in the program.
